Club Properties - General rules

- All bookings for club properties must be made direct to the Club Property CO-Ordinator.
- Only 4 (four) shooters are permitted at any time whilst on any property.
- The above 4 shooter Maximum limit applies at all times, except where the direct permission of the board of management has been granted.
- Only club members and their immediate family (non shooting) are permitted to hunt on club properties.
- Payment in full of the prescribed fee must be made to the Club Property CO-Ordinator at the time of booking.
- As payment is made to the land owner in advance by the club, there will be no refund to the member, if the member fails to turn up or fails to notify the Club Property CO-Ordinator at least 7 (seven) days prior to the booked date (This is irrespective of weather).
- It is the member's responsibility to check with the Club Property CO-Ordinator at least 10 (ten) days prior to arrival to the property to confirm the booking.
- Applications must be on the prescribed booking form only.
- The Property owner will only accept bookings for the Inner West Hunters Club through the Club Property CO-Ordinator.

WARNING: Any member abusing the privilege granted by the property owner or any of the rules of conduct will be liable to the penalties deemed appropriate by the committee of management at the time.

Property Care and Maintenance

- Respect the Privacy of the landowner at all times.
- All directions from the property Landowner or Manager must be obeyed.
- Leave gates as you find them.
- Immediately notify the Landowner or Manager of any unusual occurrences...downed stock, holes in fences etc.
- Seek permission before lighting fires.
- Construct fireplaces to minimize risk.
- Extinguish all fires before leaving camp.
- Remove all rubbish (even other peoples rubbish) or ask the Landowner or property Manager where rubbish may be disposed of.
- Offer assistance to the Landowner or Manager.
- Treat hunting areas as if they were your own.

Additional Firearm Safety whilst on properties.

- Only 4 (four) shooters are permitted at any time whilst on any property.
- The above 4 shooter Maximum limit applies at all times, except where the direct permission of the board of management has been granted.
- All hunters are to wear bright identifying garments if anyone hunts in a smaller group than the party, and must constantly identify their position.
- All hunters are to be aware of the direction and distances to both the homestead and neighbouring properties and buildings.
- All hunter groups are to carry a map of the area, a compass and a first aid kit.
- Plinking at bottles is strictly prohibited. Sighting targets are available on request to the club secretary
